## MESSAGE FROM FR. MANO

Last weekend we asked you to adopt a Saint in honor of All Saints' Day. We have been doing this for the last five years. How many of you remember all five years of your Saints? After the weekend masses, I was asking many of you about what Saint you picked. Many Saints were familiar to me. But some names I was not sure. Had any of you picked up any Saint that you didn't know anything about?

Sometimes we receive a name we already love or one that feels instantly familiar. Other times, we draw a saint we know little about. When that happens, ask why God is putting this saint in your life this year. Read a little about them or watch a show about them on Formed (it's free for our parish). Look for ways their story might connect with something happening in your own life or in the lives of those you love. St. Joseph might help you with your job situation. St. Peregrine might walk with you or a loved one through a cancer diagnosis. St. Monica might help unite your family, etc.

Consider adding the name of your saint and "pray for us" at the end of your personal prayers. And don't forget to mark their feast day on your calendar. If you remember, give yourself a treat that day to celebrate. Taking pictures belongs to our modern era. So, who could be the patron saint for Photographers? The patron saint for photography is Saint Veronica. She is my Saint for this year. I was asking God why God has given me her for this year?

She is honored for compassionately wiping Jesus' face with her veil as he carried the cross, which miraculously left an imprint of his face on the cloth. This act of capturing a "real image" is why she is associated with photography, a medium that creates and preserves visual records. I did some research to find out the meaning of her name. The name Veronica is thought to derive from the Greek "vera icon," meaning "true image," which further links her to the act of creating a perfect likeness. Yes, sometimes our names will let us know the plan of God for our lives.

It is not only great to know about our Saints but we also need to share their stories with a few people. I've already shared about my Saint. Will you? I can't believe that it's already November. I am looking forward to my trip home after Christmas. My mom already has plans for me. Some of you also will be moving to some warmer states for winter. We will miss you. You take care there.

Together, we will honor the courage, sacrifice, and love of country shown by the people who have served in our armed forces. This is a cherished tradition that reminds us of the great gift of freedom and the selfless service of those who protect it. 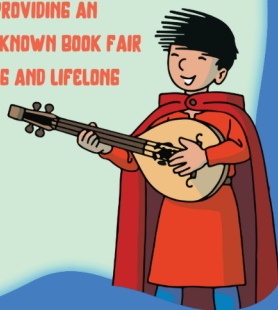

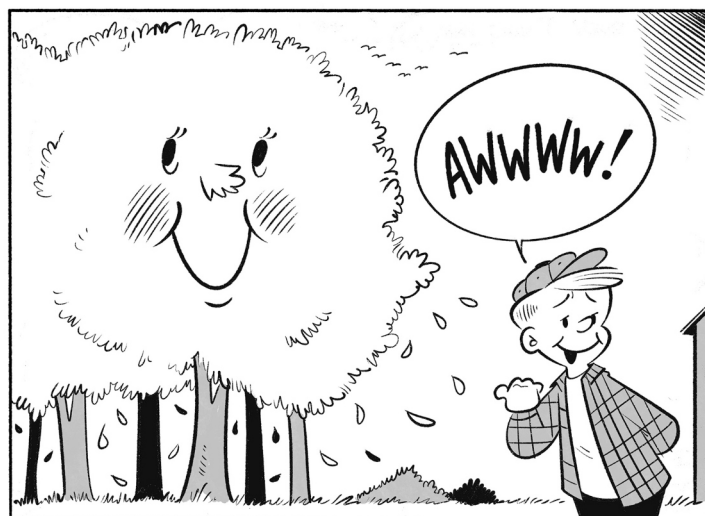
