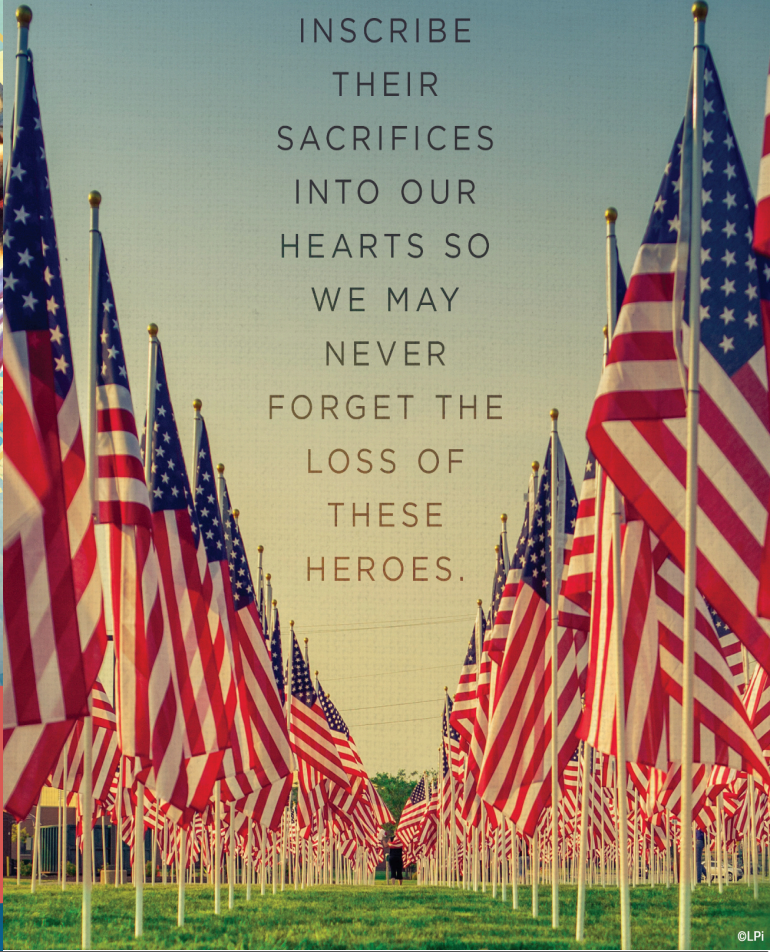

**S**ometimes God helps us in ways we do not expect. His help may not come through big miracles or at the exact time we want. Sometimes He works quietly through ordinary people, small chances, closed doors, or even difficult moments in life.

Just as God used ravens to feed Elijah in the wilderness, He can use anyone or anything to care for us. When we feel weak, alone, or tired, we should remember that God has not forgotten us. The God who made the oceans, mountains, and stars still knows how to provide for His children. Even when we ask, “Lord, where are You?” God is already at work behind the scenes, preparing the help we need.

So do not lose faith because things are taking longer than expected. Do not give up because God seems silent. Your present struggle is not the end of your story. God sees every tear, hears every prayer, and understands every burden in our hearts. Even in difficult seasons, He will provide what we need at the right time. The same God who fed Elijah, gave manna to Israel, and calmed the storm for the disciples is still faithful today.

In life, some battles are easy to see. We face struggles, fears, pressures, and problems that we openly fight against. David defeated Goliath because he trusted in God when others were afraid. But later, the same David who defeated a giant was overcome by a smaller temptation.

Sometimes the greatest danger is not outside us, but inside us. One bad decision, one weak moment, or one hidden temptation can slowly destroy what took years to build. That is why we must guard not only our actions, but also our thoughts and hearts. Not every enemy comes openly. Some come quietly through distraction, pride, temptation, and hidden sin.

The enemy cannot always defeat strong people through fear, so he often tries to defeat them through compromise. A faithful person may survive great storms yet still fall through one small opening left unguarded.

But this message is not only a warning. It is also a reminder of God’s mercy. Even after David sinned, God called him back. God corrects, forgives, restores, and changes those who truly repent.

**O**ur final week of school was a whirlwind of excitement and anticipation! Classrooms were busy with end of year activities, projects, games, and celebrations, and students were buzzing with the joy of their “impending freedom”, eagerly counting down the days to summer vacation. We took time to celebrate with our 4K students as they graduated from 4K to kindergarten. Our 5<sup>th</sup> grade class took a trip to Valleyfair and ended their years at St. Joe’s with some reflection time and a Baccalaureate celebration, including Mass with Father Mano and a wonderful reception in the gym.

We are extremely proud of our 5<sup>th</sup> grade class and all they have accomplished during their time at St. Joe’s! We send them forth with our blessings, trusting that they will carry into the world the virtues they have embraced, the friendships they have nurtured, and lessons they have learned, both in the classroom and beyond. 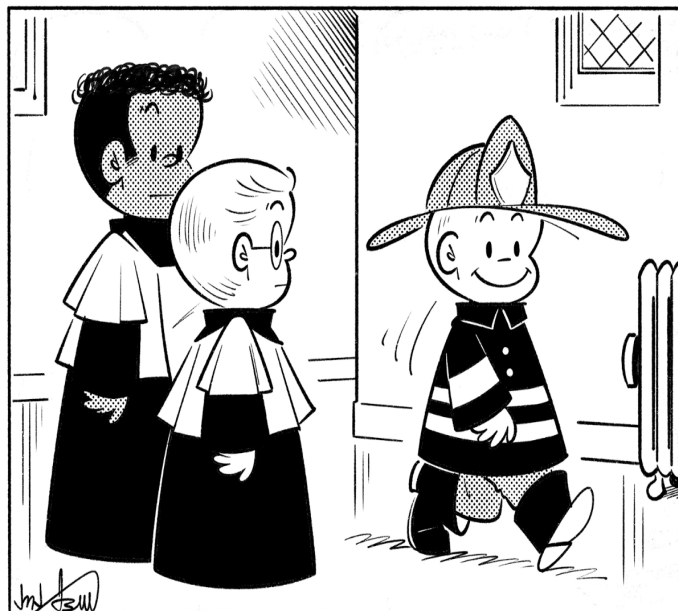
