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MESSAGE FROM FR. MANO

As I meet with parents preparing for their child's Baptism, I ask them just one question: "Do you go to church?" Some say, "Yes," but most honestly answer, "No." Do you know the most common reason they give? "Father, our child cries during Mass, and we don't want to distract the other people." Do you feel the same way? I understand that children can be unpredictable. They may cry, make noise, or need attention during Mass.

But perhaps we need to look at this from a different perspective. Children are not a distraction from the Mass—they are part of our Church family. When a baby cries during Mass, it may be inconvenient, but it is also a beautiful reminder that our churches are places for families, for children, and for all generations. We should never make parents feel that they have to stay away because their children might make some noise.

I know many families with young children who come to church regularly. I once spoke with a mother who had a baby, and our conversation turned to this very subject. She said something that stayed with me: "As a mom, sometimes I leave church feeling like I got absolutely nothing out of it. The entire time, I was taking care of my baby. She was crying. She needed a diaper change. She wanted to be held. I barely heard your sermon, Father."

I was a little sad to hear that she missed the sermon—but then she continued: "And you know what? That's okay. Because I didn't go to church just to sit quietly and listen to a sermon. I went to bring my family into the presence of God. Maybe my baby didn't let me hear every word Father Mano said, but I was still there. Maybe I spent more time in the hallway than in the sanctuary, but I still showed up. Maybe I didn't leave feeling spiritually refreshed, but I planted a seed in my children that I pray will grow for the rest of their lives."

What a beautiful understanding of motherhood—and of faith. Motherhood can make church look different. Sometimes worship looks like singing with a baby on your hip. Sometimes it looks like praying over a crying toddler in the parking lot. Sometimes it looks like changing a diaper during the sermon. Sometimes it looks like simply showing up tired, distracted, and overwhelmed.

But parents, please remember this: your presence matters. You may think you are not getting much out of Mass because you are busy caring for your children. But your children are receiving something very important. They are learning that Sunday is the Lord's Day. They are learning that church is their home. They are learning that Jesus is important to their family. They are learning to pray—not simply by what you tell them, but by what you do.

So, if you went to church and feel like you didn't "get anything out of it," remember this, 'God saw you show up'. Have you heard about our Moms group? You will find the information this weekend after the Sunday masses.
