

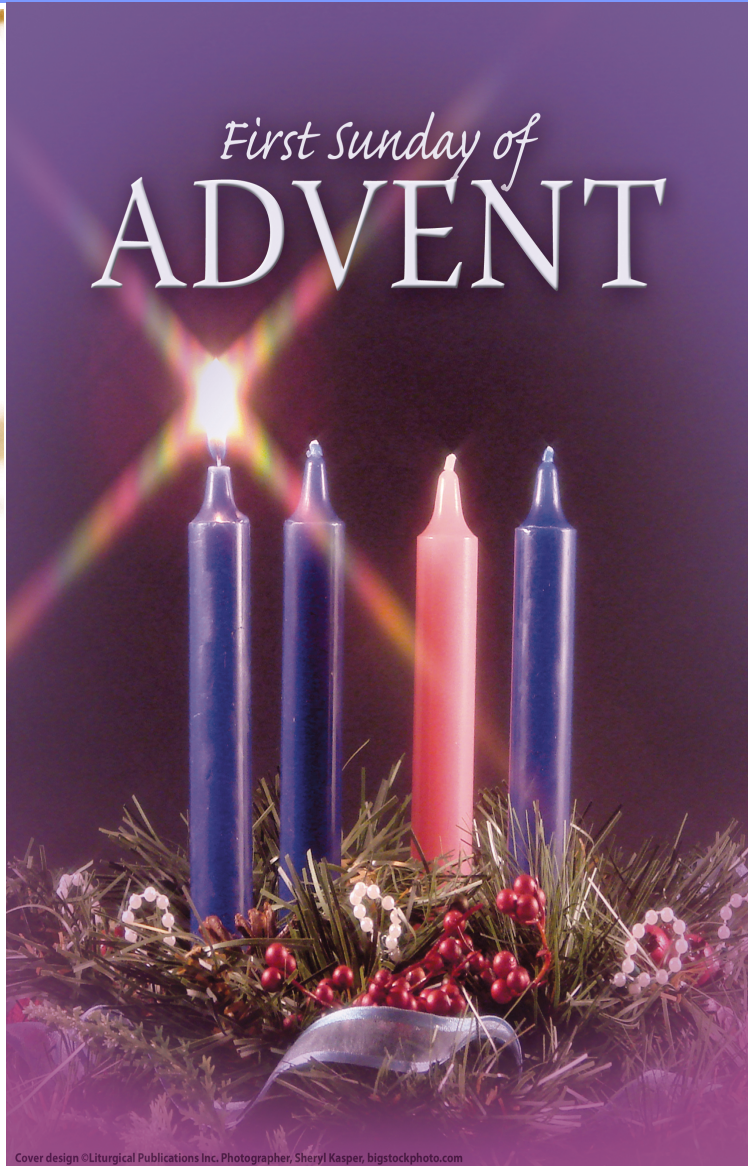

MESSAGE FROM FR. MANO

Every year I see everywhere there is a rush among people during this season. Wherever I went, there was always a line and many were waiting. Gas stations, grocery stores, gift shops, restaurants and still many other places (except in churches). People always wanted to skip the line. Have we ever thought about why we rush and what we achieve out of it? Impatient, frustrated, judgmental, unhappy and getting mad. But this is not what the Advent season is meant for.

Every year Advent returns like a gentle teacher, inviting us to slow down, breathe, and remember what truly matters. While the rest of the world rushes into December with noise, decorations, and deadlines, the Church gives us these four quiet weeks to practice the art of holy waiting.

Waiting is something we usually try to avoid—waiting in lines, waiting for news, waiting for life to “get better.” But Advent reminds us that God works precisely in the waiting. Israel waited centuries for the Messiah. Mary waited nine months for Christ to be born. And even today, we wait for the Lord to come again and to enter more deeply into our lives.

Advent is not passive. It is an active readiness time to clear space in our hearts, to let the light grow gradually, candle by candle, Sunday by Sunday. The purple of Advent reminds us to repent and reorient our lives toward Christ. The rose on the third Sunday whispers to us that joy is already on the horizon.

This season challenges us with simple but profound questions: What do I need to let go of? What do I need to take up? Where do I see hope growing, even if it's only a small spark? As we begin this holy season, let us welcome quiet moments of prayer. Let us allow Scripture to speak to our restlessness. Let us be attentive to the many small ways God is already drawing near.

May these weeks of waiting prepare us not just for Christmas Day, but for Christ Himself—coming into our homes, our hearts, our relationships, and our world. Come, Lord Jesus. Make us ready for You.
