FAITH FORMATION

Each year the Diocese of La Crosse offers the opportunity for schools and parishes to apply for the Bishop's Education Endowment Trust (BEET) Grant. This grant is used to support and assist the mission of the Diocese of La Crosse by providing funds for all aspects of parish and school Catholic education in the diocese.


In January this year, I applied for a BEET Grant to purchase new curriculum - Chosen: Your Journey to Confirmation from Ascension Press - to be used for all students in the Confirmation program.

In April, I was notified that we were awarded \$900 in grant dollars to be used toward this curriculum purchase.

New materials were purchased in August and given to students at our first session this past Sunday and there is a lot of excitement surrounding this change. In addition to student materials, this program also includes materials for parents and sponsors of each of our students.

Your donations to the Diocese through things such as the Diocesan Annual Appeal help make grants like this available to our program - so thank you!

LIVING ROSARY




October Living Rosary Gathering:
