MESSAGE FROM FR. MANO

Every time I travel to India, I'm reminded how blessed we are in America to experience a certain kind of quiet. In many parts of India, noise is constant—vehicles honking in traffic, street vendors calling out their goods, children playing in the neighborhood, music, conversations, movement everywhere. Life is vibrant and beautiful, but it is rarely silent.

That doesn't mean we are completely free from noise here. We have our own—phones buzzing, televisions playing, schedules pulling us in every direction. But compared to that constant external sound, we are often given the gift of physical quiet. But our minds feel crowded. And yet, in the middle of all that noise, Jesus waits for us in silence.

In Eucharistic Adoration, we sit before the Blessed Sacrament and simply allow ourselves to be with Him. No performance. No perfect words. Just presence. How many of us have ever experienced this? St. Joe's School kids love Holy Hour once a month. I have seen some kids who kept kneeling the whole time. They must have realized that Jesus Christ is truly present in the Eucharist. The same Jesus who calmed storms, healed the sick, and forgave sinners waits quietly in the monstrance. He does not demand. He does not rush. He simply invites.

And that invitation is powerful. Adoration teaches us something our culture has forgotten: Love grows in presence. Think of a married couple sitting quietly together. Think of a parent holding a sleeping child. Words are not necessary. Love is strengthened simply by being there (I know this for Lent, I am talking more about the family). The same is true with Jesus.

Many people say, "Father, I don't know what to say in Adoration." The truth is you don't need to say much at all. Bring your worries. Bring your gratitude. Bring your distractions. Even bring your restlessness. Sit. Look at Him. Let Him look at you. For families, Adoration can be especially beautiful. Children may wiggle. They may whisper questions. That's okay. They are learning that Jesus is real. Ten minutes with a child in the chapel can shape their faith for a lifetime.

Adoration also changes hearts quietly. Decisions become clearer. Anxiety softens. Forgiveness becomes possible. Not because we figure everything out but because we remember who is in control. In a world that tells us to hurry, Adoration teaches us to remain calm. If you have never tried it, start small. Ten minutes. Once a week. Only one in this Lent. Stop by on your way home. Kneel for a moment before picking up groceries. Let silence become prayer. The quiet power of Eucharistic Adoration is this: we do not come to fix Jesus. We come so that He can gently transform us.


