MESSAGE FROM FR. MANO

World Marriage Day, held annually on the second Sunday of February, celebrates the beauty of marriage and honors the fidelity, sacrifice, and joy of husbands and wives as the foundation of the family. It was started in 1983 by Worldwide Marriage Encounter. I didn't know anything about it until Jeff and Alice Heinzen told me. It was their idea that we do anniversary blessings for the married couples on the first weekend of every month. As I always say, this is how we show to our coming generation an example and model for Christian marriage.

World Marriage Day invites us to pause and give thanks for the beautiful, demanding, and grace-filled vocation of marriage. How many of us are thanking God for our marriage? In a world that often treats love as temporary or conditional, Christian marriage stands as a quiet but powerful witness: love is a decision, a promise, a commitment and a daily gift of self.

In the Sacrament of Matrimony, a husband and wife become a living sign of Christ's love for His Church. Their "yes" to each other is not just a private commitment—it is a public act of faith. Through ordinary moments like sharing meals, forgiving hurts, raising children, caring for one another in sickness and health—God's extraordinary grace is made visible. Can you say the few more ways you have been making God's grace visible?

Marriage is not sustained by feelings alone. It is sustained by prayer, sacrifice, and mercy. Every lasting marriage knows moments of joy and moments of the cross. Yet it is precisely there, in weakness and perseverance, that God works most powerfully. As Pope Francis often reminded us, love grows through patience, kindness, and the humble words: please, thank you, and I'm sorry.

On World Marriage Day, we also remember that strong marriages build strong families, and strong families build a strong Church. The home becomes the domestic church, where faith is first taught, love is first learned, and God is first encountered. I will always encourage family prayers at home. At least once a week find time to pray together.

As we pray in gratitude for married couples—newlyweds and those married many decades. We also pray for those struggling, for those separated, and for those who carry wounds in their family life. May all married couples be renewed in the grace of their sacrament, strengthened in hope, and reminded that they never walk alone. Christ is present in their covenant, turning water into wine, again and again.

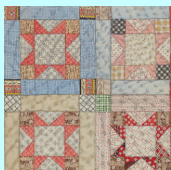

We will convene at St. Joseph Church at 7:55 AM, where maps and handouts will be provided. You are welcome to join us in Menomonie or Mondovi.

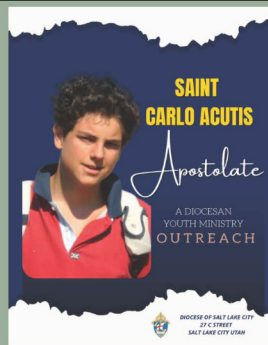
Itinerary for the Day:

This Lent, let's dedicate our time to Jesus as we come together in prayer as a community.

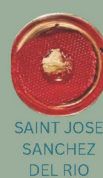

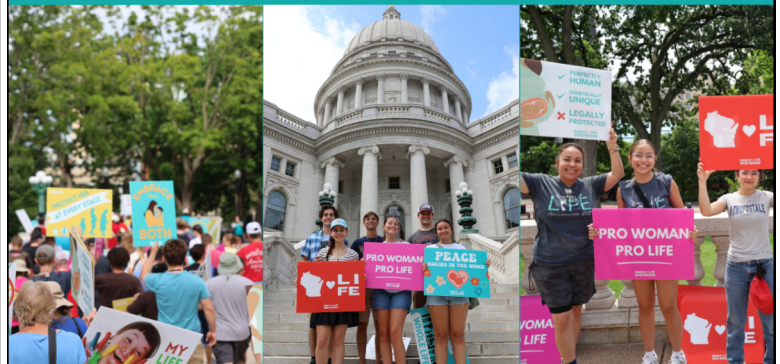
