MESSAGE FROM FR. MANO

Most of us have pets, especially dogs. Do you know the patron saint for dogs? Have you ever wondered why St. Roch is often pictured with a dog carrying a loaf of bread? It is one of the most touching stories in the lives of the saints and a beautiful reminder that God can care for us through the most unexpected means.



St. Roch (also known as St. Rocco) was born in France in the 14th century. Giving up his wealth, he became a pilgrim and devoted himself to caring for victims of the plague. As he traveled from town to town, he comforted the sick, prayed with them, and cared for those whom others were afraid to approach. Many people were healed through his prayers, but eventually Roch himself contracted the plague. (Do you recall the story of St. Damien?)

To protect others from becoming infected, he withdrew into a forest, expecting to die alone. But God had another plan. According to tradition, a dog from a nearby nobleman's estate found Roch each day and brought him a loaf of bread. The dog also licked his wounds, helping to comfort him. Curious about where his dog disappeared each day, the dog's owner followed him into the woods and discovered the suffering saint. He then cared for Roch until he recovered.

What a remarkable story! God used a simple dog to save the life of one of His saints. It reminds us that God's providence often comes through ordinary people, unexpected events, and even His creatures. We sometimes pray for miracles while overlooking the quiet ways God is already answering our prayers. (I also recall another story about Ravens bringing bread and meat every morning and evening.)

The story also teaches us something about compassion. Roch did not run away from those who were suffering. He walked toward them. He risked his own comfort to serve the sick because he saw Christ in them. In our own day, there are many people who suffer—not only from illness but also from loneliness, grief, anxiety, and discouragement. They may not need a miracle as much as they need someone willing to visit, listen, encourage, or simply be present.

Perhaps God is inviting us to be like that faithful dog. A phone call, a meal delivered to a homebound neighbor, a visit to someone in the nursing home, or an encouraging note may seem small to us, but it can become God's bread for someone who is struggling. May we have his courage to serve those in need, his trust in God's providence, and his willingness to see every act of kindness—no matter how small—as an opportunity to reveal Christ's love. Can you mention any other morals that we could learn from this story?
