

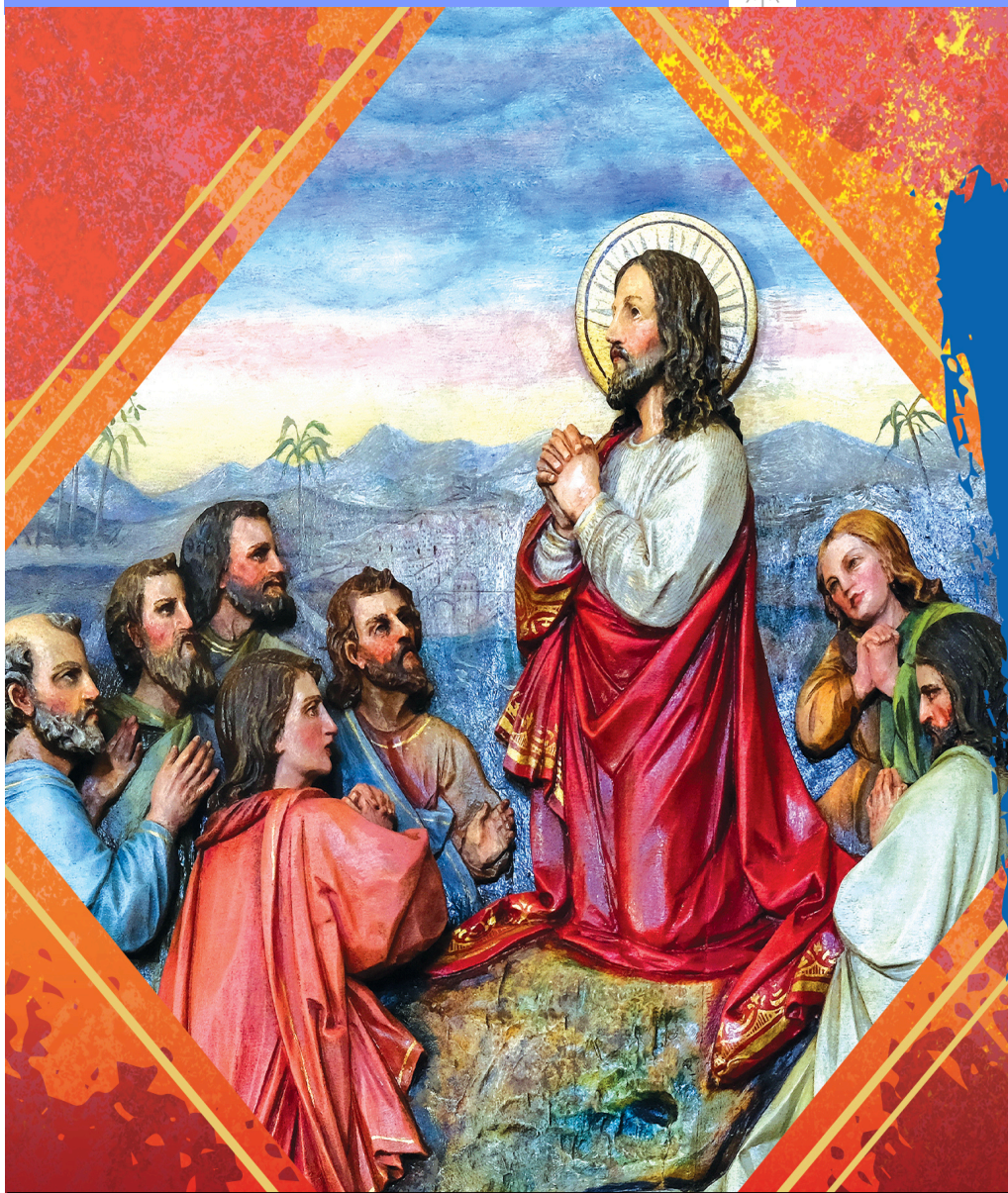

MISSION CO-OP

Dear Parishioners,

I am Fr. Nathan, Pastor at Christ the King Catholic Church, Spencer, Wi. Next weekend, July 11th & 12th I will come to your parish for the annual Mission Appeal. This appeal supports the Franciscan Capuchins of the Mary Queen of Peace Province in Tamil Nadu, India. I will be with you to preach at all Masses and share information about the missionary work of the Capuchins. I will also make an appeal on behalf of the province and its ministries.

The *Franciscan Capuchins* serve in 106 countries around the world. They are a mendicant religious order, dedicated to living the Gospel through prayer, fraternity, and service to God's people. In the Mary Queen of Peace Province of Tamil Nadu, India, the Capuchins are engaged in a wide variety of ministries. Many priests serve as pastors, caring for the spiritual needs of the faithful in 12 parishes in Tamil Nadu, India, 7 parishes in Zimbabwe (Africa), and 3 parishes in Sri Lanka.

In addition to parish ministry, some Capuchin priests are trained in counseling psychology. They provide guidance, support, and counseling to individuals, couples, and families who are facing personal, marital, and family challenges, helping them find healing, reconciliation, and hope.

The Capuchins are also actively involved in the education of children from economically disadvantaged families in our mission areas. At present, nearly 300 boys and girls are receiving care, support, and education through our three children's homes. The children stay with us for about ten months each year during the school term and return to their families during vacation periods.

These children come from poor rural families where access to quality education is often limited. Through our children's homes, they are provided with opportunities for education, personal growth, and skills development, enabling them to build a brighter future for themselves and their families.

Dear friends, I humbly request your generous support for our ministries and missions. Your prayers and financial assistance help us continue serving the spiritual, educational, and social needs of many people in India, Zimbabwe, Sri Lanka, and other mission areas. Thank you in advance for your kindness and generosity. May God reward your goodness abundantly and bless you and your families with His peace and love.

PARISH PROPERTY UPDATE

Parish Property Planning Update

After continued discussion, discernment, and review of the feedback received from parishioners and the Diocese, the Pastoral Council, Finance Council, and Buildings and Grounds Committee are moving forward with planning for the future use of the properties following the purchase of the two houses. Based on the input received, one of the primary needs identified is additional parking, including improved accessibility and parking options for our parish and school community.

An information session will be held on **Wednesday, July 15th, from 6:00pm-7:00pm in Charles Hall**. This session will provide an update on the project, share information regarding the planning process for additional parking, and provide an opportunity for parishioners to ask questions and offer feedback.

As we continue this planning process, parish leadership remains committed to keeping parishioners informed, welcoming feedback, and providing opportunities for continued involvement. The purchase of these properties provides an opportunity to address current needs while allowing our parish community to thoughtfully explore and discern future possibilities that support the ongoing mission and growth of our parish.

Thank you for your continued support, thoughtful input, and prayers as we move forward together in planning for the future of our parish.

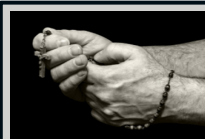
